Your wedding invitations are the first glimpse of your wedding that your guests will see. Your invitations set the tone and can provide a beautiful aesthetic, your aesthetic.

Wedding invitations are works of art when done correctly and with care and will serve as a physical reminder of all of the love and joy you feel on your wedding day. When your big day is done, you will have two things to look back upon to remember it: your photos and your invitations. The photos will elicit memories, but your invitations will elicit feelings. Long after your wedding, you will find your way back to that day when you take out your invitation suite and touch and feel the smooth and soft paper with the colors that reflect exactly who you and your soon-to-be spouse are.

Every invitation suite I create is custom and filled with care. I love every part of the process. Hearing about your vision, designing, and printing the invitations in my own home fills me with such satisfaction and a longing to create more.

I specialize in flat printing, using my own Canon Pixma Pro 200 professional printer. Letterpress and foil are also available through my special relationships with press printers.

THE PROCESS



01.

I send you a sample box of all the types of papers and bells and whistles that are available, along with a design board. We talk about your vision for your wedding, as well as the details to help you figure out exactly what you want. I have developed a questionnaire that leaves no stone unturned.



02.

Once we decide we want to work together, I begin designing. I will send you two complete suites for you to choose from. From there, customizations are unlimited.



03.

As soon as you approve your custom designs, I begin the printing process. Your wedding invitations are almost done!

If you request calligraphy or my mailing services, I will then assemble and mail them out for you. If you choose to mail on your own, I send all of the assembled invitations directly to you.



04.

If you have ordered ceremony programs, reception programs, menus, table numbers, and any other day-of stationery, we repeat the process and begin work on those!

WHY USE OCCASIONS?

My pricing is comparable, and in many cases, better than The Knot, Minted, and Zazzle, three popular online platforms. This way, you get to work with a real person and avoid the frustration of emailing back and forth with nine different people, none of whom are communicating with each other.

Online templates are confusing and generic. And DIY is difficult and time consuming, figuring out wording etiquette, how many pieces of each type of paper and stamps you need. Planning a wedding is already stressful. Your invitations don't have to be.

My invitations are entirely custom and reflect who you and your future spouse are. Customizations are unlimited. Your special suite gives your guests a glimpse into how beautiful your wedding is going to be!

I send you a complementary keepsake suite, one with all the bells and whistles, even if you didn't order them for the rest of your invitations. This is a special suite for your betrothed and you, one you will hold onto for the rest of your days.

I love this work. You want to trust that your invitations are in the hands of someone who cares for and has their heart in their work. This is not just a job for me; this is craftsmanship.
